## **OBJECTIVE**

Triune Mercy Center is a multi-cultural, multi-racial church where all are welcome. The music in worship ranges from contemporary to gospel to traditional to bluegrass to secular, etc. Often varied, local musicians are invited to play/sing to enhance worship. The Music Director develops, coordinates, and leads the worship music ministry for Triune, in consultation with the pastor and other team members, in a way that is consistent with our mission, values, and theology.

## **ESSENTIAL JOB DUTIES**

- Participate in the creative planning of the Sunday morning services and occasional, special services
- Give leadership to congregational singing during worship services – encourage and inspire enthusiastic music and singing
- Prepare choir to perform the music for Sunday morning services
- Secure and direct volunteer and paid soloists and instrumentalists as needed
- Maintain the music library and choir robes
- Coordinate the maintenance, tuning, replacement and purchase of musical instruments
- Order all music and music supplies for the Music Ministry
- Incorporate prayer in the music ministry
- Maintain a high level of musicianship
- Coordinate music/musicians for funerals/memorial services

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS**

- Ability to lead worship and to train others as individual and team worship leaders
- Ability to read stand music notation and chord charts
- Proficient keyboard or guitar player
- Skills in instrumental and choral conducting, in voice development, and in worship planning in coordination with the pastor
- Proficiency in a variety of musical styles
- Experience with technical aspects of worship such as sound boards and PA equipment
- Love and respect for people from all walks of life
- Strong interpersonal skills; can function well individually or as a team
- Committed to the church's vision, leadership, and people
