An eviction filing is a HUGE obstacle that prevents families from finding affordable housing. *An eviction filing stays on the public index indefinitely - even if the case was settled or dropped.*

YOU CAN HELP FIX THIS PROBLEM

Rep. Carla Schuessler (R-Horry) introduced the Evictions H.4270 bill in March and has been joined by 10 bipartisan co-sponsors. The bill removes the eviction filing from the public index when it does not result in an Order of Eviction or Writ of Ejectment. Eviction filings and records that resulted in settlement or debt satisfaction would be sealed after six years. Eviction records older than six years must be automatically removed.
